Hello everyone! Well we have paired up five (5) kennels and twenty-three (23) deployed teams as of April 15, 2008. April 2008 brings us to two years and eight months of operation for our “Old Dawgs & Pups and K-9 Supply” program. Once again, I’d just like to say thank you to all of you that have supported our awesome programs and especially our troops and their canine partners.

The May 2008 K-9 Supply Program report will not be distributed until late May. I will be on vacation and away on the east coast and far away from my computer!

Area of Operation Status

FOB Warrior (506th ESFS), Iraq, with six troops under the command of TSgt Andrew Esparza from the 355th SFS, Davis-Monthan AFB, Tucson, Arizona have received their Surges, Thailand Challenge Coins, Thailand Handler Patches, three Heavy Duty 24 inch floor squeegees, forty sponges, and forty cleaning/scouring pads. Sounds like they are cleaning up! FOB Warrior is being supported by K-9 personnel from Davis-Monthan AFB, AZ., Hill AFB, UT., Moody AFB, GA., Nellis AFB, NV., Holloman AFB, NM., and Mountain Home AFB, ID., and is located in northern Iraq approximately 240 kilometers north of Baghdad on the West side of the city of Kirkuk.

Manas Air Base (376th ESFS), Kyrgyzstan, with five troops under the command of TSgt Darnell Breeden from the 11th SFS, Bolling AFN, Washington, DC have also received their Surges, Thailand Challenge Coins, Thailand Handler Patches, kongs for the dogs and toilet paper for the troops – you know what they say – “You have to get the paper work done!” Manas is being supported by K-9 personnel from Bolling AFB, Washington, DC., Little Rock AFB, AR., Cannon AFB, NM., Beale AFB, CA., and Moody AFB, GA. Manas Air Base (unofficially Ganci Air Base) is a United States military installation at Manas International Airport, near Bishkek, the capital of Kyrgyzstan, primarily operated by the U.S. Air Force.

FOB Rustamiyah, Baghdad, Iraq, (an Army detachment, 4th ID in support of 4th BDE 10th Mountain Division deployed from the 374th SFS out of Yokota AB Japan) with two troops under the command of Kennel Master SSG Eric Hooker from Fort Jackson, SC, is getting geared up and we are hearing more from them each week. FOB Rustamiyah is being support by Army & Air Force personnel from Ft. Jackson, SC, and Langley AFB, VA., and is located in eastern Baghdad. Their Surges have been shipped!

Camp Victory, Iraq, with five troops under the command of SSG Joe Kirkey from the U. S. Army Detachment from Schofield Barracks, HI is now up and rolling. Camp Victory is being supported by K-9 troops from Schofield Barracks, HI., Moody AFB, GA., Little Rock AFB, AR., Kirtland AFB, NM., and is the primary component of the Victory Base Complex (VBC) which occupies the area surrounding the Baghdad International Airport (BIAP). Their Surges have been shipped!

Camp Taji, Iraq, with three troops under the command of SSG Chase Turbitt from the U. S. Army Detachment/342nd MP BN, from Ft. Leonard Wood, MO., is also up and rolling. Camp Taji is being supported by K-9 troops from Ft. Leonard Wood, MO., Ft. Knox, KY., and Ft. Jackson, SC., and is approximately 20 miles north of Baghdad.

A total of 588 pieces of equipment has been delivered to our K-9 troops serving in Iraq from August 21, 2005 to April 15, 2008.
