

#### Leatherman introduces the new "MUT" multi-tool!

COMING IN SEPTEMBER the Leatherman "MUT" is the first multi-tool that functions as both a tactical and practical tool for military, LE, or civilian shooters. This thing is built like the Surge tools we've been sending to the war zones for the last four years, and which our troops love, but it adds some really terrific features for active duty troops. We introduced this tool at the Vietnam Dog Handlers Association reunion at March AFB last spring, but all we had available at the time were some brochures (<a href="https://www.leatherman.com/userguides/950030">www.leatherman.com/userguides/950030</a> MUT Brochure web.pdf). The activeduty K-9 handlers who attended our reunion were pretty excited about the idea of a Leatherman multi-tool that would give them what they needed to disassemble, fix, adjust or un-jam an M-16 or M-4 in the field. Well, it's going to be on the market in just another few months.

The MUT has areas on the tool threaded for cleaning rods and brushes and all the screwdriver bits are sized for standard military and civilian sight adjustment. Also built into the design of the tool is the flexibility to replace the most commonly used parts on the spot, using a simple Torx #8 bit. A MOLLE sheath and scope adjustment wrench are included.
