Hello everyone! We are currently supporting nine (9) kennels and twenty-one (21) deployed Air Force, Army, and Navy teams as of May 15, 2010. Area of Operation Status - K-9 Teams Arriving/Departing



At the time of this report we have 27 members of the "Old Dawgs & Pups" program actively supporting 21 handlers assigned to nine (9) kennels in Southwest Asia.

Our K-9 Supply program has been coordinated and funded by the "Old Dawgs & Pups". The supporters are members of the VSPA, VDHA, and friends of K-9. A total of 1,147 pieces of equipment has been delivered to our K-9 troops serving in the AOR from August 21, 2005 to May 15, 2010.
