Hello everyone! We are currently supporting seven (7) kennels and twenty-five (25) deployed Air Force, Army, and Navy teams as of January 15, 2015. January 2015 brings us to nine years and five months of operation for our "Old Dawgs & Pups" program. Area of Operation Status - K-9 Teams Arriving/Departing

We are currently supporting troops at Al Udeid Air Base, Qatar; Ali Al Salem Air Base and Ali Al Salem MWD Hub, Kuwait; Al Dhafra Air Base, United Arab Emirates (UAE); and Eskan Village, Saudi Arabia; and the 1st Cavalry Division, Afghanistan; An Undisclosed Location Southwest Asia. Old Dawgs & Pup Program Overview – September 2005 - December 2014

Well, it's been nine years and four months since we started Old Dawgs & Pups due to a call for help from some troops down range at Ali Air Base, Iraq, specifically SSgt Jon Sarabia. If you don't remember, Monty and Cathy Moore first started matching up troops via the VSPA website and other venues. At the time of this report we have 25 members of the "Old Dawgs & Pups" program actively supporting 25 handlers assigned to seven (7) kennels in Southwest Asia.

Our K-9 Supply program has been coordinated and funded by the "Old Dawgs & Pups" program volunteers. The supporters are members of the VSPA, VDHA, and friends of K-9. A total of 2,189 pieces of equipment has been delivered to our K-9 troops serving in the AOR from August 15, 2005 to January 15, 2015.
