Hello everyone! We are currently supporting five (5) kennels and thirteen (13) deployed Air Force, Army, Navy, and Marine teams as of August 15, 2015. August 2015 brings us to ten years of operation for our “Old Dawgs & Pups” program. Once again, I’d just like to say thank you to all of you that have supported our awesome programs and especially our troops and their canine partners deployed down range.

Area of Operation Status - K-9 Teams Arriving/Departing

Due to the worldwide security issues and concerns for safeguarding our troops, we will not be listing the name of the bases or countries, in which our troops are deployed. All locations will be listed as “Undisclosed Location Southwest Asia” (UDL). We are currently supporting troops at four locations in Southwest Asia. We have ten (10) pups to introduce this month.

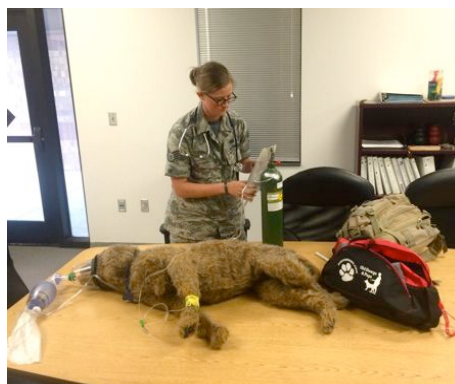

They did it AGAIN! Leatherman Donates M5 Flashlights

The generous people of the Leatherman Tool Group in Portland, Oregon, have done it for us again. They've made ANOTHER donation of 40 new LED Lenser M5 flashlights, and the M5 has been upgraded to offer even better performance than it did before. The M5 is less than five inches long and weighs less than three ounces with its battery. Most flashlights have either a shaped reflector or a special lens to focus their beam for an intended use. LED Lenser lights have both, a patented combination of lens and reflector, giving them incredibly smooth, even coverage whether they're zoomed out to cover a broad area or tightly focused for long-distance illumination. Zooming this light couldn't be easier; you can go from wide to spot by flicking a thumb or finger of the same hand that's holding the light. In my own experience, LED Lenser flashlights also provide the most even, smooth illumination I've ever seen from a flashlight, which is really nice and easy on my old eyes if I'm reading a map or book in camp at night.

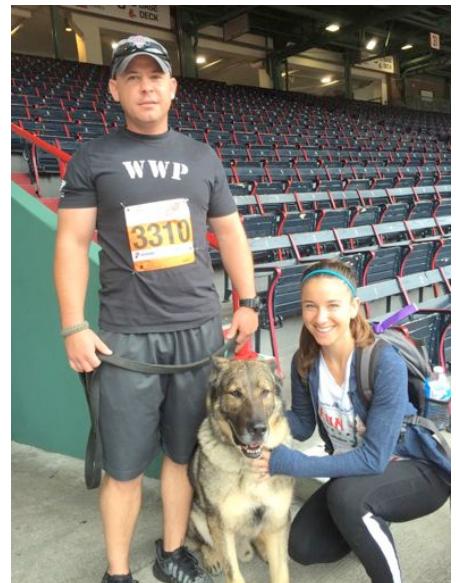
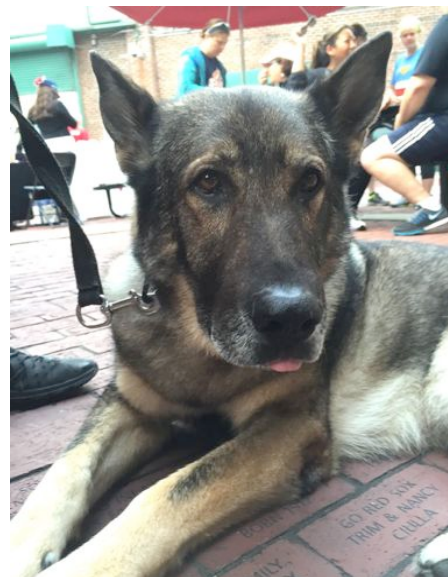
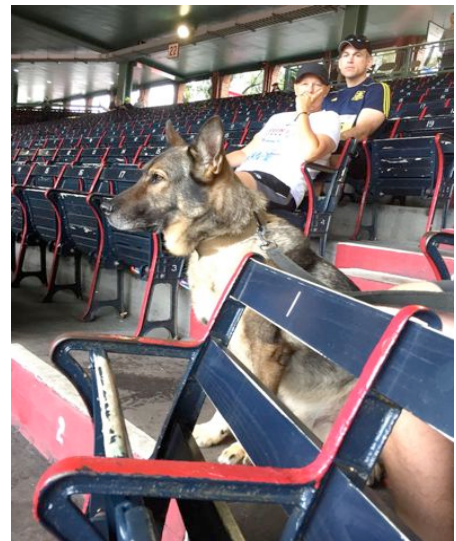
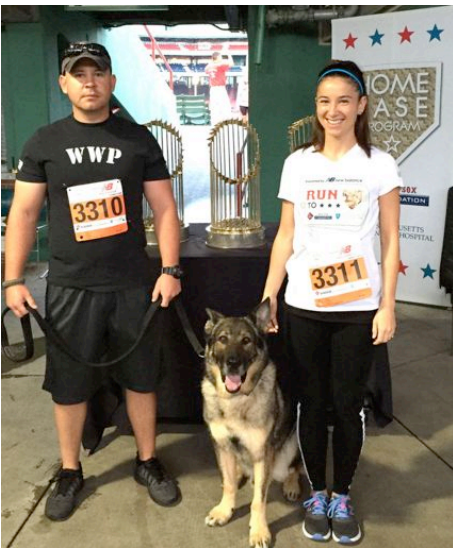
Other News concerning OD&P Graduates

OD&P graduate Walks for Veterans in Boston

“Team Figo” – Former Staff Sergeant Sean McKenna, his sister Michaela, and retired MWD Figo (K345) participated in the 2015 Run to Home Base presented by New Balance. Team Figo completed the 3-mile walk fundraiser event on July 25, 2015 in Boston, Massachusetts. The event featured food, entertainment, and family fun activities in the concourses of America’s Most Beloved Ballpark. All funds raised benefited the Red Sox Foundation and Massachusetts General Hospital Home Base Program that is dedicated to healing the invisible wounds of war for post 9/11 veterans of Iraq and Afghanistan and their families. The event took the team through scenic Boston, ending with an unforgettable experience of crossing “home base” (plate) at historic Fenway Park. Friends and family cheered the teams from the stands at Fenway. The event drew more than 4,000 participants and raised 1.5 million dollars.

Home Base opened the door to its clinic in 2009, and since then has provided clinical care, services, and support to more than 5,000 veterans and military family members from across all six New England states. Outpatient care is provided at no cost to veterans or family members.

A total of 2,503 pieces of equipment has been delivered to our K-9 troops serving in the AOR from August 15, 2005 to August 15, 2015.
