Hello everyone! We are currently supporting six (6) kennels and forty-five (45) deployed Air Force, Army, Navy, and Marine teams as of August 15, 2016. August 2016 brings us to eleven years and one (1) month of operation for our "Old Dawgs & Pups" program. Area of Operation Status - K-9 Teams Arriving/Departing

All locations will be listed as "Undisclosed Location Southwest Asia" (UDL). We are currently supporting troops at four locations in Southwest Asia. Heads At Ease Pillowcases



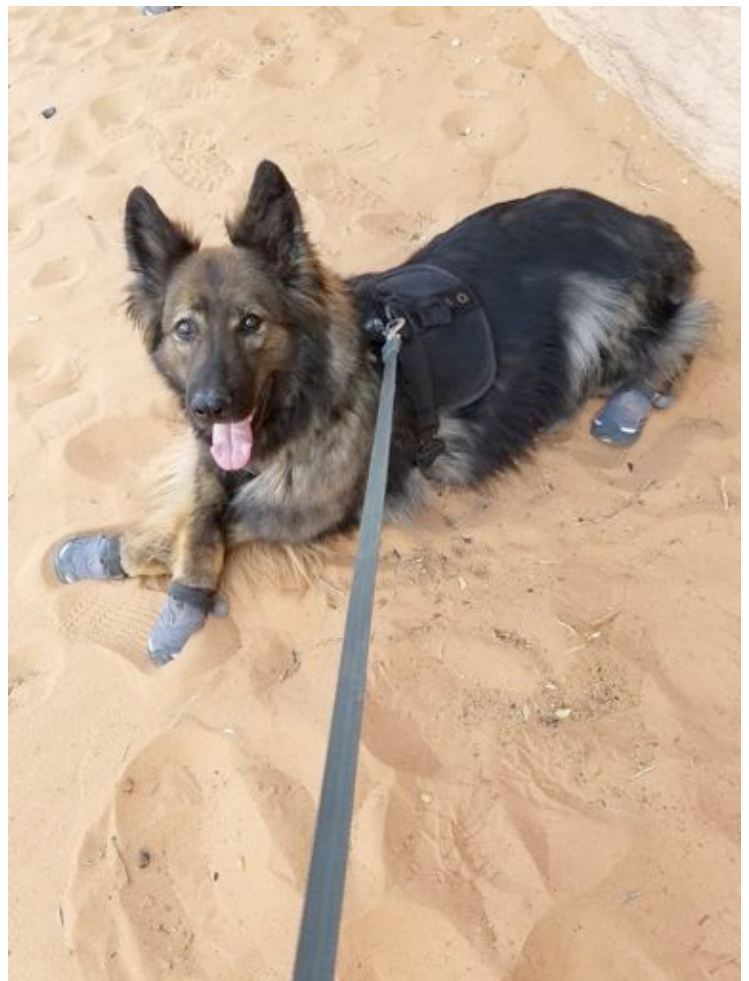

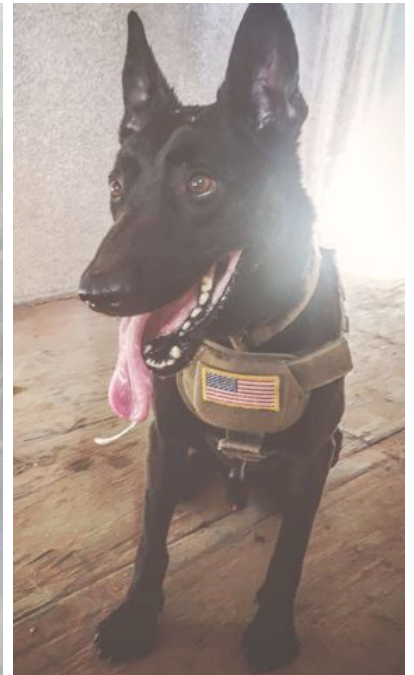

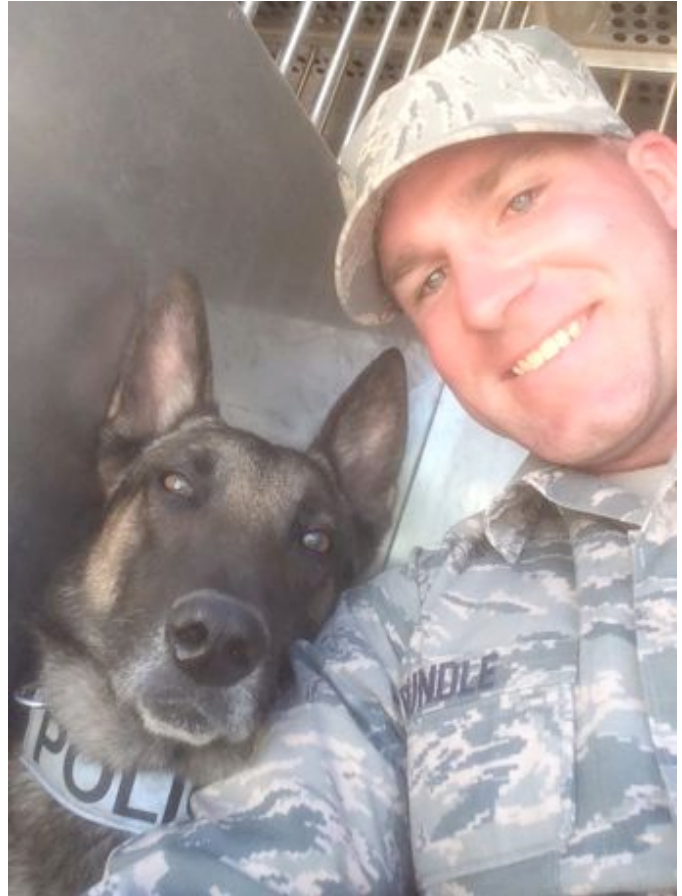

Here’s this month’s update on the K-9 Supply Program

At the time of this report we have **30** members of the “Old Dawgs & Pups” program actively supporting **45** handlers assigned to six (6) kennels in Southwest Asia.
