Hello everyone! We are currently supporting six (6) kennels and twenty-five (25) deployed Air Force, Army, Navy, and Marine teams as of November 15, 2016. November 2016 brings us to eleven years and four (4) months of operation for our “Old Dawgs & Pups” program. Once again, I’d just like to say thank you to all of you that have supported our awesome programs and especially our troops and their canine partners.

Area of Operation Status - K-9 Teams Arriving/Departing

Due to the worldwide security issues and concerns for safeguarding our troops, we will not be listing the names of the bases or countries, in which our troops are deployed. All locations will be listed as “Undisclosed Location Southwest Asia” (UDL). We are currently supporting troops at four locations in Southwest Asia. We have five (5) new pups to introduce this month.

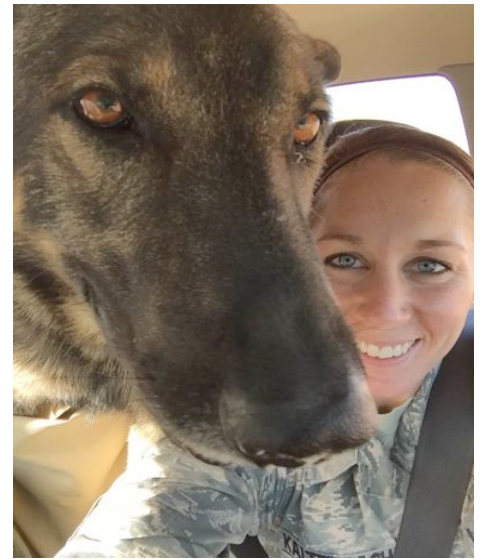
Undisclosed Location Southwest Asia #4 – 879th ESFS

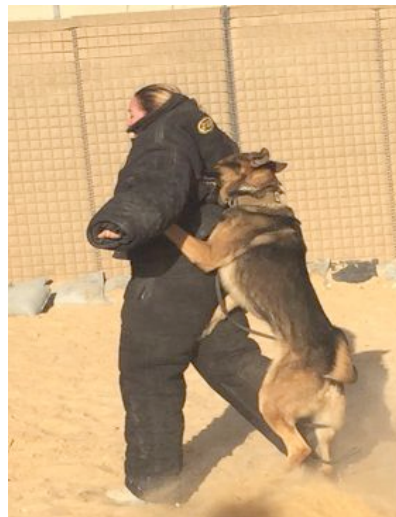

Our K-9 Supply program has been coordinated and funded by the "Old Dawgs & Pups" program volunteers. The supporters are members of the VSPA, VDHA, and friends of K-9. A total of 3,098 pieces of equipment has been delivered to our K-9 troops serving in the AOR from August 15, 2005 to November 15, 2016.
